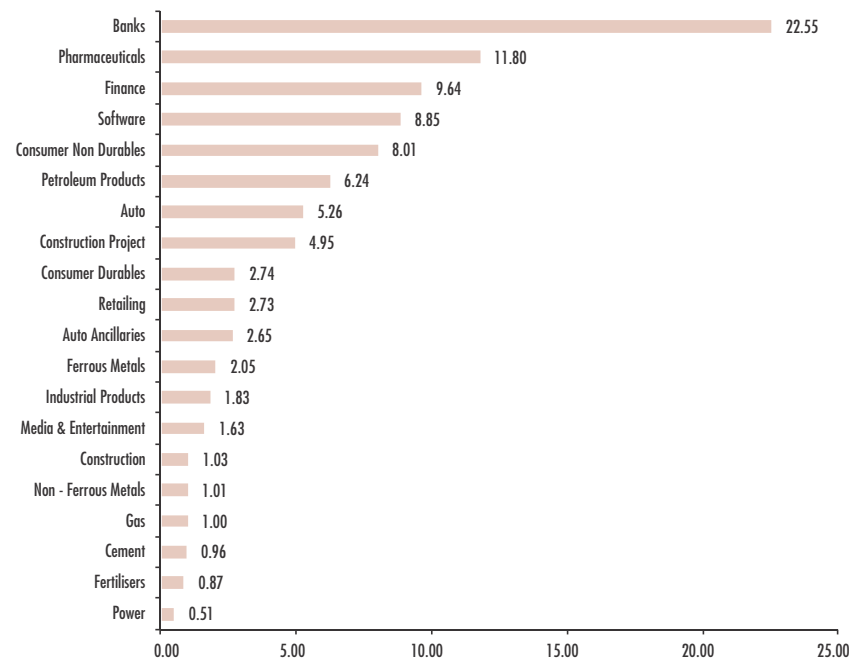

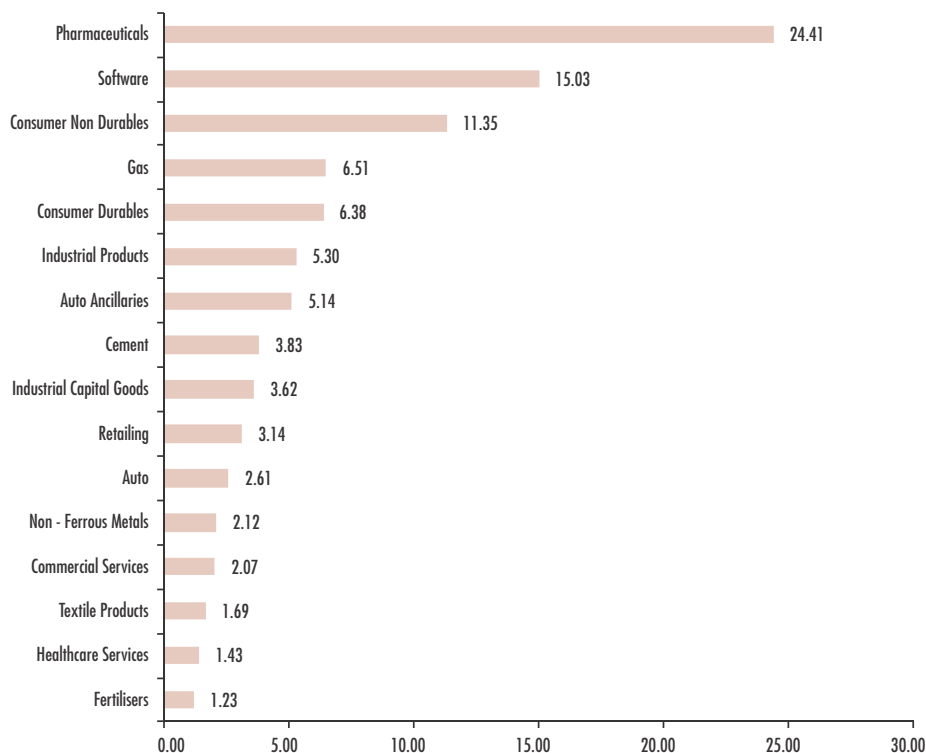

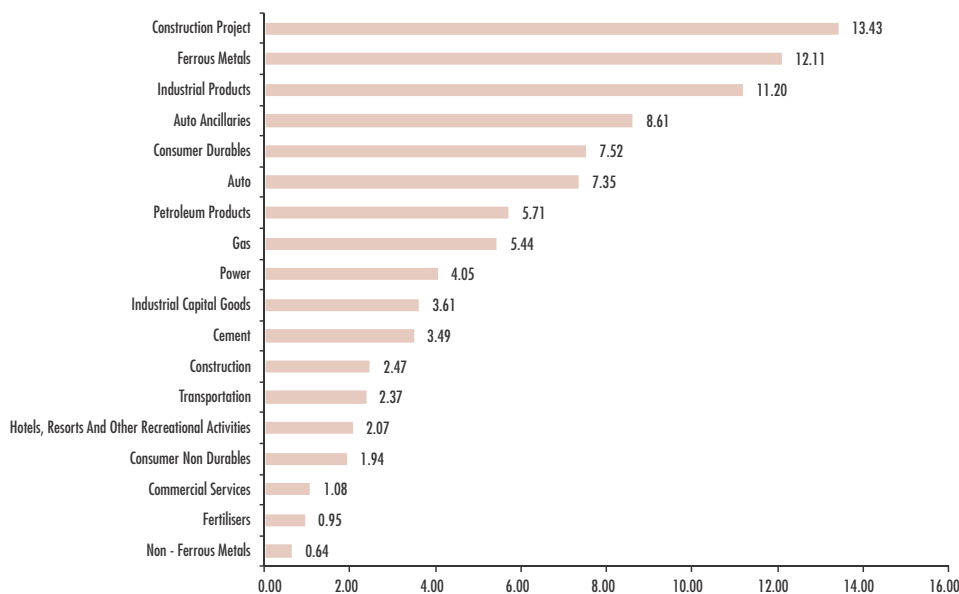

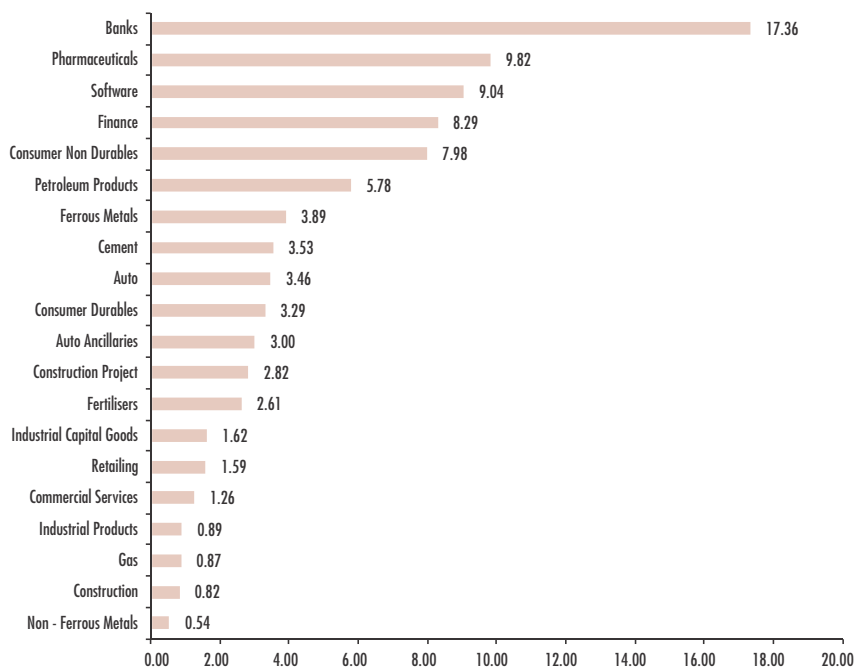

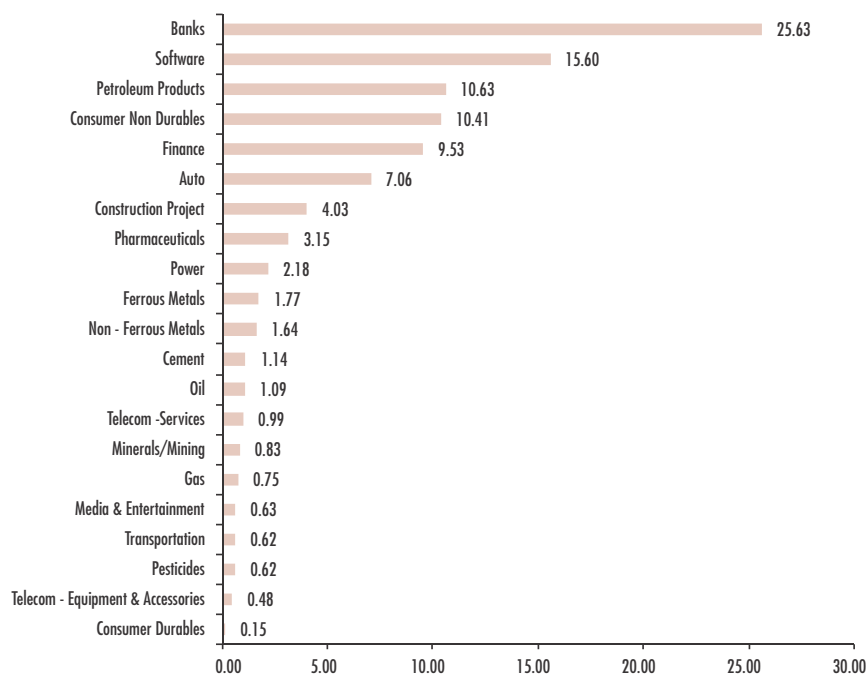

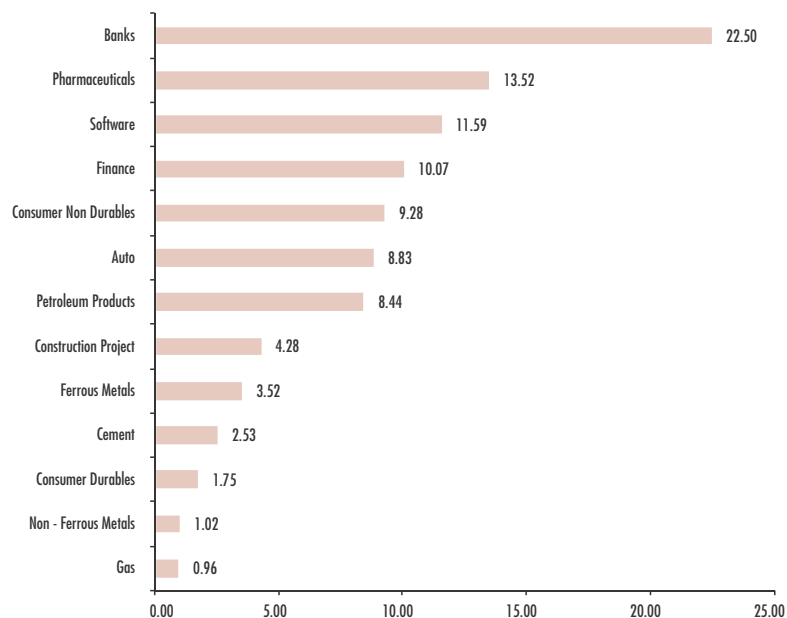

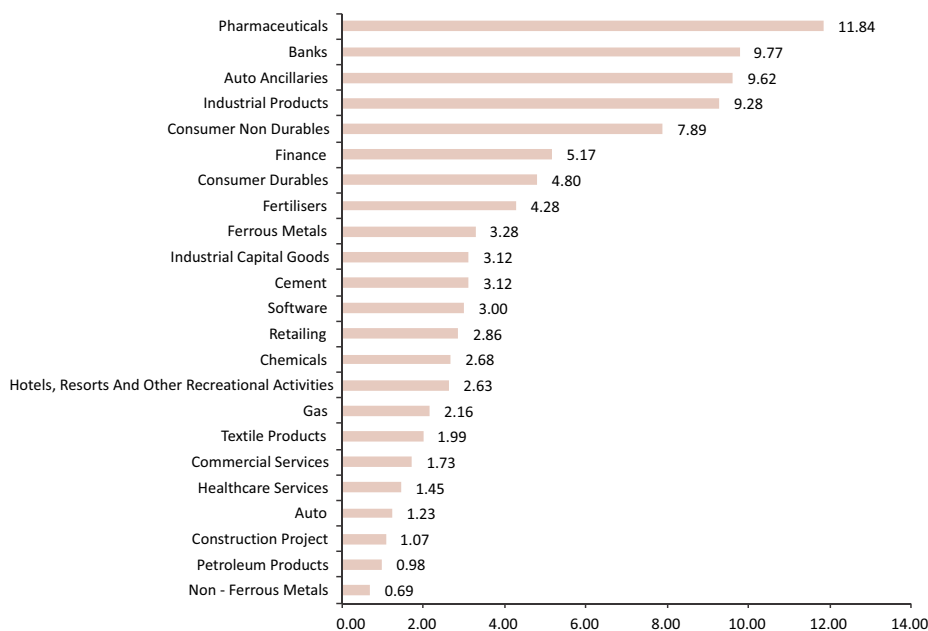

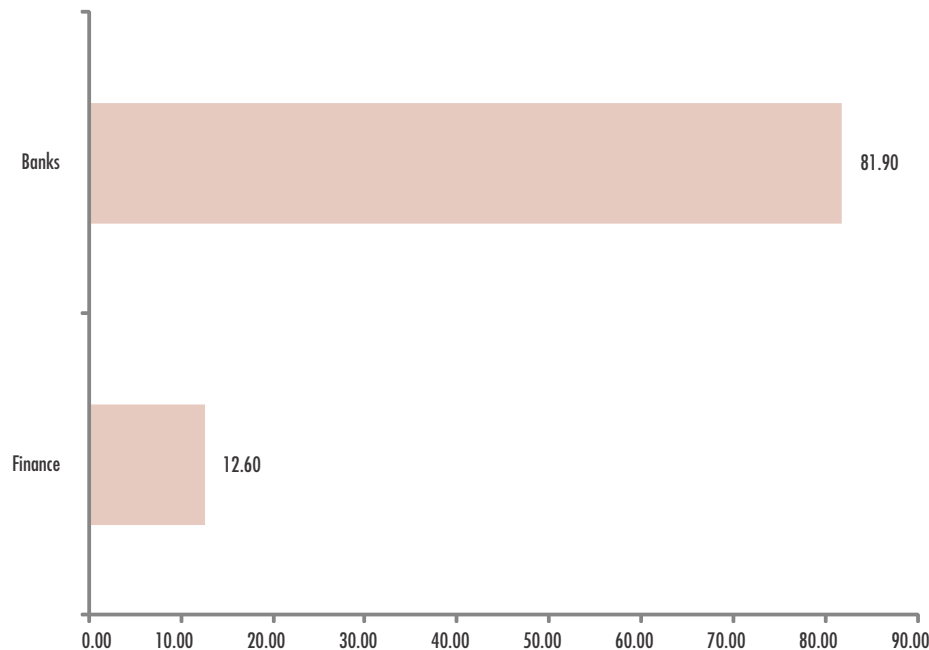

Fund Manager's Comment (Equity Schemes):

Market valuations have corrected in recent months. Volatility is likely to remain high due to some negative global cues and domestic factors such as elections, pressure on CAD and likely higher fiscal deficit.

However, if one looks at the macro picture, the situation is not as bad. Inflation has been low prompting RBI to keep policy interest rates unchanged at the latest monetary policy meet. The government has eased the supply side bottlenecks to a large extent and this has translated in benign food inflation levels. Economic growth this fiscal is also likely to be at around the 7.5% mark. The government has shown commitment to the fiscal deficit target of 3.3% of GDP and has also taken measures to rein in the current account deficit. However, 2019 being an election year, politics may take centre stage and the elections in five states (Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Telangana and Mizoram) holds the key for early signals.

Fund Manager's Comment (Fixed Income Schemes):

Significant developments/data releases in October 2018 were as under:

- RBI's monetary policy committee surprised markets by keeping policy interest rates unchanged. Consequently, the repo rate remained stable at 6.50% and the reverse repo rate at 6.25%. However, the policy stance was changed from "neutral" to "calibrated tightening". The changed policy stance effectively takes the option of a rate cut in the near future off the table.
- Surprisingly, the RBI's projection for inflation were also been revised downwards, with excessively benign food inflation driving this. Inflation is projected to be at 4% in Q2 FY 2018-19 (4.6% estimated previously), 3.9%-4.5% in H2 FY2018-19 (4.8% estimated previously) and 4.8% in Q1 FY2019-20 (5% prev).
- India's eight-core sector output grew by 4.2% in August compared to 4.4% a year ago led by uptick in production of natural gas, steel and electricity.
- The Reserve Bank of India conducted liquidity infusion through the means of open market purchase of securities (OMOs) to the extent of INR 36,000 crores, in the month of October.
- Inflation based on consumer price index (CPI) came in at 3.77% for the month of September. This was marginally higher than the 3.69% print witnessed in the previous month. Inflation however continues to remain below the 4% threshold set for the monetary policy committee of RBI.
- Inflation based on wholesale prices (WPI) came in at 5.13% for the month of September. The corresponding figure for the previous month was 4.53%.
- Index of Industrial production grew by 4.4% YoY for the month of August as against 6.5% for July.
- Fiscal deficit for the half year ended September 2018 came in at INR 5.94 trn. This is more than 95% of the yearly budgeted fiscal deficit. This means that if the government has to meet its deficit target of 3.3% of GDP, government revenues have to grow at a significantly faster pace (as compared to expenditure) in the second half of FY 2018-19.
- We also witnessed the revelation of the rift between the RBI and the Government on major policy issues. RBI Dy Gov. Viral Acharya gave a significantly vocal speech defending RBI's autonomy and cautioning the government that interference in matters which are the principally the domain of RBI would not be taken kindly by financial markets.
- Principal areas of disagreement between the RBI top brass and the government are
 - 1) The Prompt Corrective Action norms that RBI has imposed on several banks and which the government wants to be relaxed so that these banks can lend again;
 - 2) The government's move to set up a separate regulator for the payment systems infrastructure, to which the RBI has filed a public dissent note.
 - 3) The need for retaining surplus income on RBI's balance sheet instead of distributing 100% of the surplus to the government.
- International oil prices continued to soften aiding bond market sentiment.
- The benchmark 10 year government bond closed the month trading at a yield of 7.78%, down by 24 basis point from the closing levels of the previous month.
- Yield on 10 year AAA PSU bond traded at approx. 8.70%, a fall of 15 basis points from the previous month.
- One year CDs yielded about 8.35%, lower by 5 basis points over the previous month.

How to read Factsheet

Fund Manager : An employee of the asset management company such as a mutual fund or life insurer, who manages investments of the scheme. He is usually part of a larger team of fund managers and research analysts.

Application Amount for Fresh Subscription : This is the minimum investment amount for a new investor in a mutual fund scheme.

Minimum Additional Amount : This is the minimum investment amount for an existing investor in a mutual fund scheme.

Yield to Maturity : The Yield to Maturity or the YTM is the rate of return anticipated on a bond if held until maturity. YTM is expressed as an annual rate. The YTM factors in the bond's current market price, par value, coupon interest rate and time to maturity.

SIP : SIP or systematic investment plan works on the principle of making periodic investments of a fixed sum. It works similar to a recurring bank deposit. For instance, an investor may opt for an SIP that invests Rs. 500 every 15th of the month in an equity fund for a period of three years.

NAV : The NAV or the net asset value is the total asset value per unit of the mutual fund after deducting all related and permissible expenses. The NAV is calculated at the end of every business day. It is the value at which the investor enters or exits the mutual fund.

Benchmark : A group of securities, usually a market index, whose performance is used as a standard or benchmark to measure investment performance of mutual funds, among other investments. Some typical benchmarks include the Nifty, Sensex, BSE200, BSE500, 10 - Year Gsec.

Entry Load : A Mutual fund may have a sales charge or load at the time of entry and/or exit to compensate the distributor/agent.

Entry load is charged at the time an investor purchases the units of a mutual fund. The entry load is added to the prevailing NAV at the time of investment. For instance, if the NAV is Rs. 100 and the entry load is 1%, the investor will enter the fund at Rs. 101

Note: SEBI, vide circular dated June 30, 2009 has abolished entry load and mandated that upfront commission to distributors will be paid by the investor directly to the distributor, based on his assessment of various factors including the service rendered by the distributor.

Exit Load : Exit load is charged at the time an investor redeems the units of a mutual fund. The exit load is reduced from the prevailing NAV at the time of redemption. The investor will receive redemption proceed at net value of NAV less Exit Load. For instance if the NAV is Rs. 100 and the exit load is 1% the investor will receive Rs. 99.

Modified Duration : Modified duration is the price sensitivity and the percentage change in price for a unit change in yield

Standard Deviation : Standard deviation is a statistical measure of the range of an investment's performance. When a mutual fund has a high standard deviation, it means its range of performance is wide, implying greater volatility.

Sharp Ratio : The Sharp Ratio, named after its founder, the Nobel Laureate William Sharpe, is a measure of risk-adjusted returns. It is calculated using standard deviation and excess return to determine reward per unit of risk.

Beta : Beta is a measure of an investment's volatility vis-a-vis the market. Beta of less than 1 means that the security will be less volatile than the market. A beta of greater than 1 implies that the security's price will be more volatile than the market.

AUM : AUM or assets under management refers to the recent / updated cumulative market value of investments managed by a mutual fund or any investment firm.

Holdings : The holdings or the portfolio is a mutual fund's latest or updated reported statement of investments/securities. These are usually displayed in terms of percentage to net assets or the rupee value or both. The objective is to give investors an idea of where their money is being invested by the fund manager.

Nature of Scheme : The investment objective and underlying investments determine the nature of the mutual fund scheme. For instance, a mutual fund or growth fund. Likewise, a mutual fund that aims at capital preservation by investing in debt markets is a debt fund or income fund. Each of these categories may have sub-categories.

Rating Profile : Mutual funds invest in securities after evaluating their creditworthiness as disclosed by the rating. A depiction of the mutual fund in various investments based on their ratings becomes the rating profile of the fund. Typically, this is a feature of debt funds.

Tax Benefits / Consequences: The Dividend Distribution Tax on distribution of income by equity oriented fund to all the investors shall be payable at the rate of 11.648%* and no distribution of income by other than equity oriented fund to an individual / HUF shall be payable at the rate of 29.12%* and at the rate of 34.9444%* on distribution of income to any other investor.
